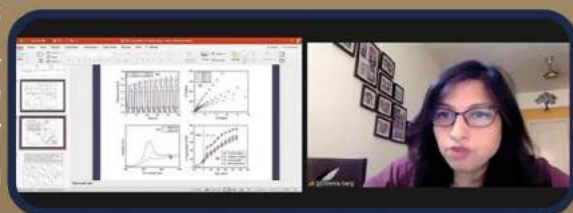
Skill Up with Webinar

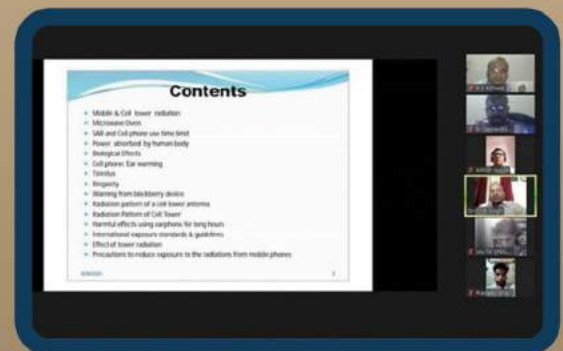
3. Computer Science & Engineering: *Operating System for all Innovations*

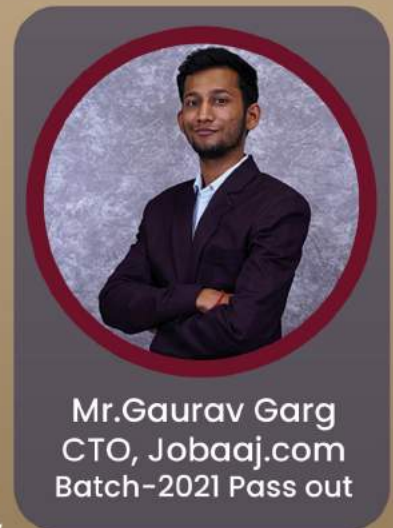
The Incredible Stories.....

Education for an Inspired Life:

I am 21. I was born in Hodal. I did my early schooling from ISM public Sr. Sec. School, Hodal and I took admission to Eshan College of Engineering in August of 2017. In college I used to live in a hostel and it was a lot of fun. The Hostel freedom also allowed me to think more liberally and make decisions for myself. In college too, I had really good relations with my teachers because I was pretty dedicated towards my academics. The academic and college discipline also helped me a lot further down in my career too. Being in hostel, I had some extra time on my hands that helped me take up a lot of self-learning projects. I have also given a lot of extra effort into learning about the different technological trends and implementing them. Since I didn't know much about CS, the college helped me a lot get oriented with the field. Perhaps the one who helped me the most was our HOD of that time "Ajit Saxena" Sir. He helped me at every step of my journey. Not to ignore the fact that since I was from a lower financial background, I was aided financially

by the college due to the help of Manjari Ma'am. My academic struggles proved fruitful when one day I got a call from our HOD sir who had recommended my name for an internship that was being provided by our college. It was the post-covid time and I was at the end of my third year so I grabbed the opportunity. Later when I visited the office, I interacted a couple of times with the company's MD and proposed different ideas and approaches to him. He was impressed by my dedication and academic knowledge and in a month, I was promoted to the position of Senior Developer. It was then that I directly reported to the M.D. We made a lot of changes to the approaches and the technologies which we were using earlier. I introduced a lot of new and efficient technological models that could be used to further improve upon the company's technical requirements. Very soon I was given the command of managing the company's tech operations as well as R&D department. I was thus promoted to the post of CTO in a span of 1 year. Being a startup, time is a crucial factor for us. We used to work 11-12 hours daily and it can become quite hard to be working for that long and still keep your productive consciousness active and yet I managed. I was in almost no contact zone with my friends, had a very less time with family, and found it difficult to manage my studies along with it, but I persevered. Now, I have learnt to deal with it. Also in my field of work I also practically work with concepts like cloud computing, artificial intelligence, etc. So it becomes bit easier preparing for the exams. At last I'd just like to say this to my juniors, there are seldom shortcuts anywhere, you should always focus on what you really want and lastly, **HARD WORK ALWAYS PAYOFF!**

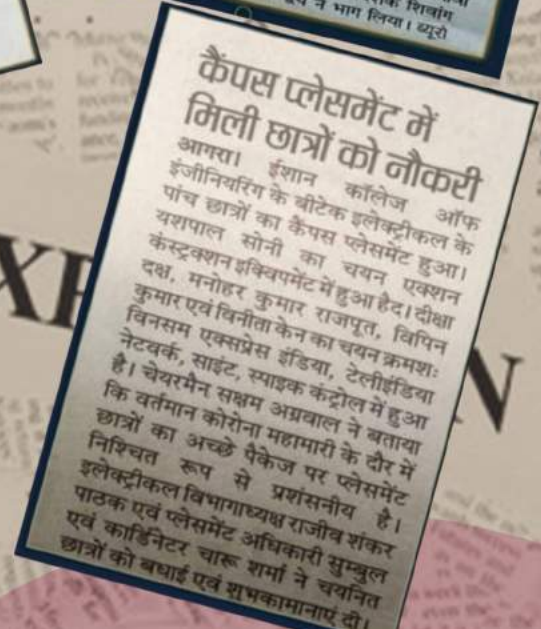
